
Dear Sirs:

The Civil Aviation Registry has received the documents pertaining to SCI AERO SCI.AERO CYBER QUAD, serial number _____ Temporary number _____ has been assigned. The following item(s) are required before registration of the experimental aircraft can be completed:

- a. Show the model of the aircraft on the affidavit. It appears the model is Cyberquad. Draw a single line through Sci Aero.
- b. Show the complete name of the builder on the affidavit and the application. If you make any corrections draw a single line through what you are correcting. See item 6 on the enclosed information sheet.
- c. Show the complete name of the seller on the bill of sale. See item 6 on the enclosed information sheet.
- d. Show corporate title for the person signing the enclosed bill of sale.
- e. Submit a signed statement that answers items 7-8 on the enclosed information sheet. The received documents did not have this information.
- f. Submit a statement from the official having jurisdiction over the national aircraft registry of Australia that the aircraft has never been registered or that the registration has ended or is invalid. The statement must show the official's name and title, and must describe the aircraft by manufacturer, model, and serial number.
